Therefore, players are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of their age group programme with their County Age Group Manager.

As a player within Norfolk Cricket Board County Youth you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- All players must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All players must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Players should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- All players should demonstrate the expected level of behaviour whilst representing the county, both on and off the field, upholding the 'Spirit of Cricket' at all times.
- Players must wear Norfolk Youth Cricket kit for all training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Players must abide by the ECB / NCB codes on use of Social Media relating to CAG Cricket at all times
- Players are not allowed to smoke whilst representing the county.
- Players are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst representing the county at training, matches and tours. (Including those who may be legally able to consume alcohol)
