

Norfolk Cricket Board Player / Parent Helmet Policy 2023

Norfolk Cricket Board / Norfolk Youth Committee

The Norfolk Cricket Board (NCB) in 2016 issued new mandatory rules on the use of appropriate helmets for all players representing Norfolk age group teams. This policy has arisen following the new ECB Guidelines on the new recommended standards for helmets. The ECB guidance and further information can be found at www.ecb.co.uk/helmets

The NCB's policy is as follows:

"The Norfolk Cricket Board states that it is mandatory, for all County Age Group Players to have a helmet that meets the new standards as set out by the England and Wales Cricket Board. This is to ensure that every child has the best possible protection at a consistent level across all age groups. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their child is in possession of the correct standard of helmet for all matches and practice. Players that do not have the correct helmet protection may be stopped from playing by their Coach or Manager."

Agreement:
